**Where We Go:** This workshop is a unique opportunity to capture images of animals in their natural habitats, concentrate on advancing your wildlife photography skills and building your professional portfolio. At Triple D Game Farm, you are given the once-in-a-lifetime chance to photograph animals which may include bobcats, mountain lions, wolves and bears in a controlled environment. For over 30 years, Triple D has been caring for animals while providing a place for media outlets, including the BBC, National Geographic and Disney as well as individual photographers and filmmakers, thus ensuring a photographic opportunity that is safe for you and the animals alike.

**What You Learn:** Through honest and encouraging critique sessions, Neil works with you to build upon your strengths and increase your understanding of photographic topics. He offers pointers on composition, exposure, methods for capturing motion, and provides training on the equipment that is best suited for taking pictures of wildlife. You leave this workshop with incredible images of animals, a better ability to anticipate a critical moment and a heightened sense of respect for all wildlife.

**Who Should Attend:** You should be comfortable with the manual exposure operation of your camera. Both digital images and 35 mm slides and can be critiqued.

This workshop is limited to 12 participants.  
Tuition includes admission fee into the game farm.
