Workshop Details

Each day will begin with a meeting with the Triple D staff who will let us know the best times to photograph the animals based on weather and other factors. Many of these days may start early. After we have photographed our species in the morning, we will break for lunch and reconvene in the afternoon to review the shoot and work on technique and composition. This time will include guided lectures and have the opportunity for critiques and question and answer sessions.

The fourth day will be dedicated to learning to print digitally and each participant will leave with three images from their time at Triple D. This day is also the best time to ask any questions about Photoshop or Other Imaging Programs.

I will have an assistant that will help organize, explain, and be there for anything you may need. Our mission is to promote and enhance your photographic education, and we will strive to achieve these goals!
