Chris Navarro will be co-hosting a sculpting workshop with the Triple “D” Game Farm. Professional Artist Chris Navarro will instruct a three day workshop using the “Big Three” Triple “D” animals as models. Chris will be instructing in the outdoors with the wildlife model a few feet away and in the comfortable Triple ‘D’ conference room. The fourth day, September 13th is considered an “Optional Day” for participants who would like to continue viewing, sketching, photographing and sculpting from a selection of 28 species. This is an exciting event.

A message from Chris on his instructional approach

It is important to remember every expert was a beginner at some time. So the most important thing to bring to this class is a hungry mind, the desire to sculpt and a positive attitude. We will study armature construction, anatomical proportion, composition, design and gesture. We will also look for that hidden spark that brings the essence of life into our own work. Working with oil base clay and using live models we will sculpt a Grizzly bear, Mountain lion and Siberian tiger with trained handlers. We’ll be working very close to these animals. Bring your camera and sketch pads for a once in a lifetime experience. Visit Triple “D”’s web site at www.triplegamefarm.com for more information.

Using live models will help us respond and interact more intensely with our subjects. You need to be inspired and excited by your subject to give the best that is within you. We will discuss many topics both the physical and mental challenges of being a sculptor, from creating monuments to working with foundries., the ins and outs of marketing and promoting your work, establishing relationships with galleries and everything in between. If what you create is real and if it’s done with genuine emotion there will always be others who will want to experience and relate to that power.
