### Birds of Prey

The Triple "D" is proud to announce an optional session scheduled for the morning of **September 22, 2010** with the "**Birds of Prey**" photo session. Lynn Vaught of "Wildlife Return" has agreed to exhibit her birds in a natural setting for photography groups organized by the Triple "D". Wildlife Return is a rehabilitation center dedicated to the care of injured, ill and orphaned wildlife. Lynn Vaught is dedicated to the rehabilitation of the wildlife that come to her for help with the ultimate goal of releasing those back to the wild that can sustain themselves. Other than her resident birds, it will not always be possible to determine what birds will be exhibited until the time of the photo session. What can be guaranteed is full session consisting of several hours with adequate time to observe, sketch and photograph each Birds of Prey. All sessions are scheduled to commence with morning light. These sessions are often in conjunction with Triple "D's" wildlife sessions. Individuals can choose to participate in both sessions or just one. For those participating in the "Birds of Prey" a meeting is scheduled for September 22, 2010 at 8:30am at the Triple "D" Office.



### Don't miss the Exciting Horse Roundup Session!!!

**New!** The Triple "D" has expanded the annual September Special to include an optional session referred to as "**Horse Roundup**". Arrangements have been made with several local ranches to utilize their beautiful horse herds for two photo sessions. You can expect to photograph a variety of colorful horses running through water or creating dust as they run, accompanied by western dressed wranglers. The sessions are planned for the afternoon of **September 22, 2010** and the morning of **September 23 2010**. The event will be limited to 15 participants. These sessions are added as an extra and are not considered part of the annual September Special. **An organizational meeting for photographers participating in only the "Horse Roundup" is scheduled for September 22, at 2:00pm, at the Triple "D" Office.**



### Fees:

- \$150 per species (minimum 6 species) a total of \$900
  - Additional species are \$150 per species per photographer
  - A \$200 deposit is required to reserve space in the July Special
- \$175 for optional "Birds of Prey" session.
  - \$100 deposit required to reserve a spot
- \$550 for optional Horse Roundup Session.
  - \$200 deposit is required to reserve a spot
- Accompanying non-photographer fee is \$50 per day
- Reserve a room at Triple D's Guest House, The Howling Wolf, \$75 for single and \$85 for a couple.
  - First night deposit is required
- All deposits non-refundable unless the Triple "D" cancels the session.
- Triple "D" reserves the right to cancel all sessions and refund deposits in full. Species may be substituted if health problems arise.
